- Generate inventory reports that document inventory counts, discrepancies, shortages, FIFO, Fill Rate, and other statistical data.
- Reporting inventory statistics to management and suggesting improvements to inventory control.
- Coordinating with warehouse to resolve discrepancies in inventory.
- Generates Purchase Orders to replenish inventory, enter and update tracking information, monitor shipment status and receipts, schedule docking times (loading and unloading)
- Purchases and manages inventory on stocked items and includes 3PL customer.
- Responsible for transferring and monitoring items between multiple warehouse locations.
