- Leads the communication on Best Before Dates report.
- Handles the Returns Process in coordination with warehouse and Operations teams.
- Lead the Year-End count and related procedures.
- Assist in Non-Conformance Reporting (NCR) and recall procedures.
- Develop Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) documents as required.
- Works closely with Operations, Accounting, and Sales on projects solving inventory issues.
